"As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the **calling** you have received." Ephesians 4:1

Chapters 1-3 are a detailed explanation of these Gentile Christ-followers' **Calling**:

- This Calling includes an **explanation of God's Plan**. "...to be put into effect when the times reach their fulfillment—to bring **unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ**." 1:10
  - This Calling includes a reminder of how the Calling was Accomplished.

"For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." 2:10

 This Calling includes our inclusion into a "Living Stone Temple" aka the Church

"His intent was that now, **through the church**, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms" 3:10

In trying to think of a way to help me & I hope us grasp it, I would ask that we think of a Sandwich!

"Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another		
in love. <sup>3</sup> Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond		
of peace. Ephesians 4:2-3		

"If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. <sup>2</sup> If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. <sup>3</sup> If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing." I Corinthians 13:1-3

"There is **one** body and **one** Spirit, just as you were called to **one** hope when you were called; <sup>5</sup> **one** Lord, **one** faith, one baptism; <sup>6</sup> **one** God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all." Ephesians 4:4-6

\*Problem 1: Does my list of Essentials match those of the Bible?

\*Problem 2: If my understanding of the Essentials is correct, do I represent them correctly?

"When he ascended on high, he took many captives and gave gifts to his people."

 $^9$  (What does "he ascended" mean except that he also descended to the lower, earthly regions?  $^{10}\,\rm He$  who descended is the very one who ascended higher than all the heavens, in order to fill the whole universe.) Ephesians 4:7-10
